# What Is Your Personal Information?

- Full name
- Birth date, SSN, Medicare card, veterans info
- Previous addresses, parents' names
- Any personal ID info
- Make copies of documents



## Who Can Make Decisions?

- Estate plan includes life events
- POA, advance medical directive, etc.
- Medical information -- comprehensive
- Documents and details
- Keep it all updated

It doesn't do any good if no one knows about it and where to find it



## What Insurance Do You Have?

- Need comprehensive list
- All the details plus documents
- Life insurance especially important
- Don't forget employer and veterans coverage
