### Your Retirement Is Unique, but...

- Universal goals
- Universal issues
- Key questions need annual review
- Some apply even if continue working



#### #1: When Will I Retire?

- Saving ends, spending begins
- Affects many factors
- Need contingency plans
- Benefits of working longer



# #2: When Should Social Security Benefits Begin?

- Any time from 62 through 70
- Use nest egg instead?
- Coordinate with spouse
- Survivor's benefits are key



#### #3: How Does My Nest Egg Become Lifetime Cash Flow?

- How much guaranteed lifetime income do I have?
- Invest for total return or income?
   How much risk?
- What is my safe spending policy?
- What about inflation?



### #4: Which Medicare Choices Should I Make?

- Determines out-of-pocket cost, care
- Know the gaps in Medicare
- Traditional Medicare vs. Advantage
- Traditional needs Medigap, Part D
- Can it be changed?



# #5: Should Spending Be Adjusted?

- Know fixed vs. flexible expenses
- Are investment returns, income lagging?
- Are there unexpected expenses?
- Are changes long-term or temporary?



# #6: How Will I Be Cared For If Help Is Needed?

- Need long-term care contingency plan
- Most likely to affect surviving spouse
- Where do you prefer care?
- Who will provide? How will it be paid?
- Are documents in place?



## #7: What Is My Protection From Financial Fraud & Abuse?

- Cognitive ability will decline
- Need to avoid isolation
- A team is best approach
- Legal protections: Trusts, POA



# #8: How Can I Use Home Equity?

- Significant asset for many
- Might not have to move.
- Options:
  - Reverse mortgage
  - Other borrowing
  - Sell and downsize



# #9: How Will The Surviving Spouse Be Protected?

- When retirement plans fall apart
- Don't leave planning burden on survivor
- Income likely to decline
- Expenses likely to increase
- Have a checklist, resources



#### #10: What Legacy Do I Want To Leave?

- How much? To whom?
- Will I reduce my standard of living?
- Is the structure in place?
- Is it still up to date?
- Are my wishes changing?
